Application Requirements AY 2024-2025

Overview

Hokkaido University One Program for Global Goals (OGGs) is a graduate program designed for students to take a wide variety of classes offered in English in the fields of Culture and Society, Environment, Science and Technology.

Eligibility

Students who fulfill all the conditions of 1-2 below.

1. Students who are equivalent to either condition of (1)-(2) as of June 2024.
 - 1) Students who are enrolled in a graduate degree program (Master / Ph. D) and will continuously be enrolled during participation.
 - 2) Students who [will] have acquired Bachelor's degree and will enter Master program by the beginning of the participation in the program.
 - 3) (For STSI Course Participants)
Students who are in 4th year and 5th year at Dual Degree can also apply for the program.

2. Students whose GPA is above 2.30/3.00 over the last one year.

(For NJE3 and PARE Course Participants)

*Applicants must have sufficient English proficiency to take the course.

If you do not have the following certificate, you will need to take the Duolingo English Test.

-TOEIC: 550

-TOEFL (ITP/ PBT/iBT/CBT): 500/61/173

-IELTS: 5.0

Student Support

Students admitted to the OGGs Program are eligible for the following.

- Accommodation (Dormitory) booking during the OGGs Program period.
- Documentation support in Visa procedures
- *Visa fees, etc. are at your own expense.

Regarding financial supports, although OGGs Program Participants may apply for JASSO scholarship which assist international exchange students, this support are not promised at present.

There would be a limited number of scholarships available depending on the selection results, only a few students may be able to receive them.

As the selection results will be notified after the deadline of application duration to OGGs Program (in January 2024), please assume to cover their own costs during the stay in Japan.

(For reference)

JASSO scholarship: 80,000 Yen / month

Living cost: 80,000-100,000 Yen / month

Expenses

Students are responsible for the followings.

- Travel Expense
- Overseas travel insurance
- Visa-related expenses
- Other living expenses (e.g. Dormitory fees, food, transportation, etc.)
 - *Dormitory and utility fees during the OGGs Program period: approx. 30,000 – 40,000 Yen/month
- Comprehensive Insurance for Students Lives Coupled with "Gakkensai": approx. 2,500 – 3,500 yen in total
(when you arrive Japan, we will instruct you)
- (Advanced Program only)
 - National Health Insurance (Japanese governmental Insurance): approx. 2,000 Yen/month

Application

STEP1:

Submit the application documents to OGGs Liaison Office of your university.

- 1) AY2024 OGGs Application Form
- 2) Academic transcript of home institution of last one year (Translated in English)
- 3) Official Certificate of Enrollment of home University (in English)
- 4) Copy of passport
- 5) (For NJE3 and PARE Course Participants)
Copy of Official English proficiency test certificate

Deadline at Home University: November 10th (Fri.), 2023

*Please submit all application documents to OGGs Liaison Office of your home university by this date.

*Please note that there will be screening at your home university.

*Please ask through OGGs Liaison Office at your home university if you have any questions about the application for the program.

After the selected notification, submit an online application on HSI website.

Certificate of Completion

(Basic Program)

Participants are required to acquire the following 5 credits for the Certificate of Completion.

- 3 credits in Basic Subject
- 2 credits in “SDGs Field Study” designated by each OGGs course

(Advanced Program)

NJE3 and PARE Course participants who complete Basic Program can apply for Advanced Program and are required to acquire the following 4 credits for the Certificate of Completion.

- 2 credits in “SDGs Advanced Field Study” designated by each OGGs course
- 2 credits in “SDGs Overseas University Seminar (Specialized Subjects)”

STSI Course participants are required to acquire the following credits for the Certificate of Completion.

- 3 credits in Basic Subject
- 2 credits of “SDGs Advanced Field Study: Long-term Independent Research Experience on STSI (STSI)”
- 2 credits in “SDGs Overseas University Seminar (Specialized Subjects)”

Notes

- Any funding will not be provided under any circumstances to students unable to remain in Japan for the period specified by OGGs Central Office.
- Students are responsible for expenses relating to personal trips and home-country visits regardless the circumstances.
- Students should take out overseas travel insurance before leaving your country for the program.
- Students are **NOT** allowed to trip around in Japan for sightseeing before OGGs program starts.
- Students must send flight information such as itinerary of the flight tickets to OGGs central office in advance.

STSI Course:

STSI Course aims to foster professionals with the ability to maximize results in endeavors that address various issues related to transportation systems and infrastructure development in India through Japanese/Indian teamwork. Particular focus is placed on the establishment of the Japan-India Sustainable Development Consortium with the cooperation of the business communities in Japan and India towards promoting continuous person-to-person exchanges and the development of human resources so that students in both countries can work closely to achieve sustainable development that addresses not only the positive aspects of transport systems and infrastructure but also negative aspects, such as environmental and local impacts.
