Prerequisites and language requirements

- **60 ECTS credits** first cycle/undergraduate/bachelor courses in industrial engineering or business administration or computer information systems or equivalent.
- **Fluency in English.** All applicants are required to meet the standard English language requirements corresponding to English 6 in the Swedish upper secondary school system. Read more about the language requirements here: [language requirements](#).

Tuition fees and costs

- Tuition fees: 25 000 SEK
- Application fee: 900 SEK (All Swedish Universities charge a mandatory application fee of 900 SEK (approx. 80 Euro) to citizens **outside the European Union (EU), European Economic Area (EEA) and Switzerland to process and review an application**). - Accommodation: Between 3500 – 5000 SEK per month
- Welcome lunch and Farwell dinner

Social and Cultural package: 1500 SEK. The package includes the following: company visits, welcome lunch, farewell dinner, certificate ceremony, and social and cultural activities such as a trip to one of Sweden's best-preserved castles from the 16th century in Vadstena, a trip to Gränna; a charming city where traditional Swedish peppermint candy canes are handmade, a visit to the ruins of Brahehus Castle, after-school activities, a Swedish Midsummer celebration and much more! New for 2024 is the moose safari tour.

Cancellation policy

Any cancellation will be fully reimbursed if made before 1 May 2024. Cancellations between 1 May and 31 May will be reimbursed to what is equivalent to half the cost of the program. Cancellations after 31 May will not be reimbursed.

Insurances

The students are covered by Personal Injury Insurance for students. The insurance applies in Sweden and covers injuries during school hours and during travel to and from the location where school hours are spent.
